WHEREAS the Village has implemented a permit process for the Pierson Park Picnic Pavilion to streamline the approval of organized activities, provide for appropriate maintenance and staffing when needed, and ensure awareness of and adherence to park rules;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tarrytown will hold a Public Hearing at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on Monday, June 8, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Building, One Depot Plaza, Tarrytown, New York to consider a local law to amend Chapter 221 of the Tarrytown

Code, Section 5 entitled Alcoholic beverages in parks and public areas to allow for the service and consumption of alcohol at events within the Pierson Park picnic pavilion and the picnic pavilion lawn area, provided that a permit has been issued by the Tarrytown Recreation Department.

6. Resolution for National Police Week 2022

Resolution to recognize National Police Week 2022 and to honor the service and sacrifice of those law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty.

WHEREAS, there are more than 800,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Village of Tarrytown;

WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1786, more than 23,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, DC;

WHEREAS, National Police Week 2022 will be observed from May 15–21, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT , in RECOGNITION OF all fallen officers and their families on May 17, 2022, U.S. flags on Village buildings will be flown at half-staff; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Village publicly thank our police officers for their service to our community and in communities across the nation.

7. Salary increases for non-union employees
