Dear Tarrytown Water Meter Customer:

The Village of Tarrytown is embarking on a comprehensive replacement of residential and commercial water meters throughout the Village in Spring 2023. Last replaced in 2006, the Village water system meters are past the end of their useful life, and are failing, resulting in a reliance on estimated water usage for billing. This problem will only continue to worsen, and impedes our ability to accurately bill our water system customers.

The Village has contracted with **Ferguson Waterworks** to implement the replacement of the meters, and **Saks Metering** will be conducting the installation. You can find information about the project, the water meters, and what to expect on our Village webpage:

Upgrading our water meters brings several advantages. In addition to accurate measurement of water usage, the new meters will give access to an online portal that allows water system customers to track their water usage on a regular basis. This can help customers identify leaks and issues in their system when water usage increases unexpectedly. In April 2023, we anticipate the replacement of water meters will begin in commercial properties, and the residential properties will continue thereafter. We anticipate the project will be ongoing for the remainder of 2023.

You will receive additional communications as the installation launch gets closer. In addition, the Village will be hosting two in-person community information sessions in the Tarrytown Senior Center to answer questions on **Thursday, April 13**th **at 6pm** and on **Thursday, May 11 at 2pm** which will also be accessible on Zoom. The Zoom login information will be available on the Village online calendar:

<u>https://www.tarrytownny.gov/calendar</u>. We will have staff members and representatives from the contractor available to answer your questions.

You can expect additional communications from Ferguson, Saks Metering, and the Village, once the installations begin. Saks Metering will be reaching out to help you schedule an appointment two to three weeks before your installation is scheduled to occur. All contractors working on this project and Village staff will be required to show photo identification.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation on this important water system project.
