Tarrytown Wins Gold Award in AAA's Annual Traffic Safety Program

The Village of Tarrytown has won a Gold Award in AAA Northeast's Community Traffic Safety Awards Program, Director of Public / Government Affairs & Traffic Safety, John Corlett announced today. Additionally, the Village received a special citation for having five consecutive years with zero pedestrian fatalities.

The Village was recognized for its many traffic safety efforts including the addition of intersection traffic cameras that are directly monitored at the police station, allowing immediate dispatch to correct any problems that arise. Updated crosswalk signals, signs and markings and have been added to refresh older ones. The Police Department also implemented a pedestrian safety campaign to address the need for pedestrian crosswalk enforcement.

All award winners in the New York metropolitan area were honored during a luncheon ceremony held October 17th at the Garden City Hotel. AAA Northeast, the local AAA affiliate, presented a total of 60 awards.
